Jaggi Vasudev calls businessmen

Sadguru Jaggi Vasudev, founder of Isha Foundation, a significant delegate to the 21st Annual India Economic Summit held at Delhi was conspicuous in the meet by his incisive observations calling for a more comprehensive economic and social developments policies.

His specific suggestions around issues such as rural health, education, the environment, responsible media and infrastructure sought to ensure that any long term economic development was equitable and brought wellbeing to the entire population of the Indian sub-continent. His observations on the growth forecasts also exposed potential systemic vulnerabilities and helped enhance the delegates' understanding of the economic and social realities of India. The opening plenary session revolved around the rapid pace of economic growth of Indian economy, a theme that was reiterated throughout the

meeting - projecting a sustained economic growth of about 8 per-cent.

In Delhi, Sadguru and Isha Foundation also hosted a session on Inner Engineering to emphasize the truth that economic development without individual well being was unsustainable and the individual well being stimulates holistic economic development. The Sadhguru also made it clear that economics did not have to divorce spirituality in order to thrive because spirituality in the yogic tradition is always practised as a subjective science. Sadhguru Jaggi Vasudev would also be participating in the World Economic Forum in Davos and would also address a meet at the Bombay Stock Exchange and in the series of programmes, he would be engaging business leaders with penetrating insights into economics, society, the environment and above all human wellbeing.
